Compound that with a medical condition (such as HIV), and an orphan in Africa, without food or medication, is given a death sentence. World AIDS Day and the Orphan Crisis - Foster2Forever - and 2001, the proportion of orphans whose parents died from HIV/AIDS rose from 3.5 per cent to 32 per cent.

There are more than 34 million orphans in the region today, 11 million of them orphaned by HIV/AIDS.³ Figure 1-1 shows the most recent estimate of children orphaned by HIV/AIDS published in Children on the Brink 2002.
